SELECT PROGRAM 2024-2025



Select program registration fees for USYS National League Elite 64 (E64) teams include the costs of USYS National League E64 league fees, USYS National League Quarterfinal and/or USYS National League Semifinal event fees, regional tournament and/or college showcase registration fees, USYS Wisconsin State Championship registration fees, one winter indoor league (or additional tournament if no indoor league), and coaches' travel expenses for all of the above leagues, events, and tournaments. Registration fees for these teams also include coaches' travel in the event of qualification for the USYS National League Semifinals, USYS Midwest Regional Championships, and/or USYS National Championships.

USYS National League E64 teams will not deposit into team accounts, as the expenses typically paid from team accounts have been budgeted and included in these teams' registration fees to promote cost certainty.

Personal travel expenses and uniforms will continue to be the responsibility of each player and are not included in select program registration fees. Select program uniforms are purchased on a two-year cycle. The Fall 2024 season will mark the second year of the current two-year uniform cycle.



Starting with the 2024-2025 soccer year, registration fees for select program premier, classic, and non-E64 elite teams will include the costs of registration for WYSA or USYS league play, one winter indoor league, USYS Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualified), and **one tournament for each season (fall and/or spring) during which they play**. Previously, registration fees for these teams did not include baseline tournament registration fees (bolded above).

All select program premier, classic, and non-E64 elite teams will continue to collect a \$200 deposit per player, which will be paid into the team account at the beginning of the season. The team account will be used to pay for additional tournament registration fees (**beyond the one fall and/or spring tournament registration now included**), coaches' travel, and other incidental team-related expenses. This approach allows maximum flexibility for teams that participate in different numbers of leagues and/or tournaments, both locally and regionally. If the team account is depleted, each family will be asked to contribute a pro rata share of remaining expenses. In the event of a team account surplus at season-end, each family will be refunded a pro rata share of the remaining funds.

Personal travel expenses and uniforms will continue to be the responsibility of each player and are not included in select program registration fees. Select program uniforms are purchased on a two-year cycle. The Fall 2024 season will mark the second year of the current two-year uniform cycle.

ELITE 64 NATIONAL EVENTS



USYS will be rebranding its national events for the 2024-2025 season as follows:

- National League Quarterfinals (formerly E64 Playoffs)
- National League Semifinals (formerly National League P.R.O.)

Participation in national events is based on team/club performance in National League play during the 2023-2024 season.

The National League Quarterfinals in November and January will primarily feature National League E64 teams, while the National League Quarterfinals in December will primarily feature National League Premier 1 teams and E64 Regional League teams. Teams that advance from the National League Quarterfinals will participate in the National League Semifinals. Teams advancing to the National League Semifinals will compete for berths directly to the USYS National Championships.

The following slide summarizes the 2024-2025 national event pathway, including dates and locations. **Please note, teams will attend only one USYS National League Quarterfinal event. USYS has not assigned clubs/teams to each event. The Club will provide this information to our E64 teams as soon as it becomes available. Please do not make travel arrangements until you receive confirmation of which USYS National League Quarterfinal event your team will be attending.**

Registration fees include USYS or WYSA league play, one tournament or college showcase, Brookfield Sports Complex winter indoor league, Wisconsin State Championship or President's Cup (if qualify), and training during the fall (girls) and spring (boys) outdoor and winter indoor seasons. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION



- A one-time volunteer fee of \$150 will be charged to each family at registration. This amount will be refunded upon completion of a volunteer job for each of the family's children registered with the Club
- Referee fees are initially paid by each team, but are reimbursed by the Club
- Teams may find sponsors and/or fundraise; however, all fundraising must be approved in advance by the Elmbrook United Board of Directors
- All tryouts are conducted by the Elmbrook United coaching staff and other qualified evaluators
- According to the WYSA Tryout Policy, U11-U15 players will be notified of roster offers no earlier than noon on June 14, 2024, and U16-U19 players will be notified of roster offers no earlier than noon on June 21, 2024
- Notifications of roster offers will be communicated via PlayMetrics and email, and will continue until rosters are complete
- Players who are offered a roster spot have 24 hours to accept the offer



- If offered players do not notify the Club of their acceptance within 24 hours, their roster spots may be given to first alternate players
- Once offers are accepted, players will have until noon on Wednesday, June 19th (U11-U15) or Wednesday, June 26th (U16-U19) to register through PlayMetrics and pay the initial installment of their registration fee
- If players do not register by the dates referenced above, their offers may be rescinded and given to first alternate players at the Club's discretion
- Registration fees may be made in installments, and applications for financial aid are located on the Club's website
- Players are expected to commit to a team for the entire seasonal year (i.e., August 2024 through July 2025), and are expected to attend all team training, matches, tournaments, and events, barring extenuating circumstances
- Players will not be excused from team activities without their coach's consent, and unexcused or frequent absences may negatively impact playing time
